Incident:
I was stopped on the shoulder of SE Lake Umek RD and Cumberland Kanasket RD SE. I was facing N/B. I saw 2 ATV's S/B on Cumberland Kanasket RD. Both turned onto Lake Umek RD behind a Black Jeep. I signaled for them to pull over. I saw the first ATV was a W/M. He had his gray sweatshirt pulled over his nose and mouth preventing me from getting a good look at him. The second ATV rider was a female. She had a white dog on her lap. I turned on my emergency lights and attempted to get them stopped. All three vehicles drove E/B on SE Lake Umek RD. As they approached the railroad tracks, it looked as though one was going to turn S/B onto the tracks. I turned on my siren and the W/M immediately turned onto the tracks S/B just as the black Jeep stopped. He almost hit the back of the Jeep. The red ATV quickly drove around the Jeep and continued about 100 yds and pulled over when I got alongside her.

Jenee said she knows she is not supposed to drive her ATV on the road but she wanted to go to someone's house and give them their dog back. I asked her who the other rider was. She said she did not know, and after asking her several times, Jenee said she thinks his name is Adrian, but that is all she knows. She said the Jeep was with them. I spoke to the driver in the Jeep. He said he has no idea who the other rider is, and only met him at Jenee's house.

SE Lake Umek RD is a dirt road. I told Jenee not to ride her ATV on the pavement or it may be impounded next time she is caught.

As I was leaving the stop, I saw a pedestrian walking N/B on the tracks and walk onto W/B Lake Umek RD. His name is Josh and he said the male on the quad that fled was on the tracks S/B. Josh said he had to get out of the way so he would not be hit by the driver.

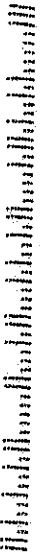

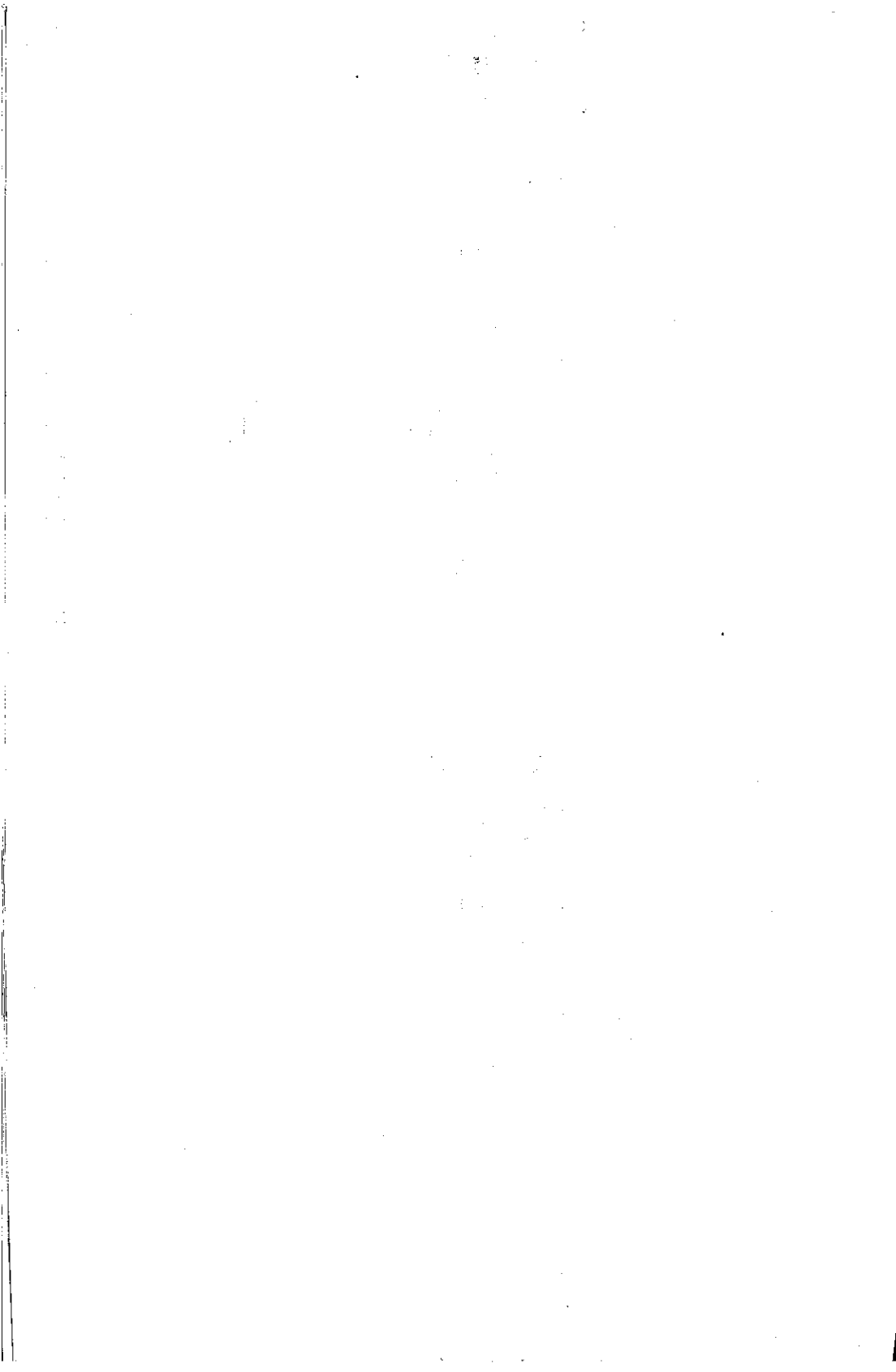
